TERMS OF THE MOU

GENERAL REGULATIONS, ELIGIBILITY AND ENROLMENT -

- 1) The two parties agree to enter into a student & faculty exchange agreement, commencing in the academic year 2018-19.
- 2) The participating students will register at the host institution for the full academic year or for a minimum of one academic term.
- 3) Each institution may send up to 20 students per academic year to participate in the various activities or events organised by the both parties. The number of participants may be increased subject to the mutual agreement of both institutes.
- 4) It is expected that in any given year there will be an equal number of students exchanged from each institution.
- 5) Notwithstanding Clauses 3 and 4 above, while equal numbers in every year may not be possible, efforts will be made to have equal numbers exchanged over a five-year period.
- 6) The candidates will be selected by their respective institutions to participate in the exchange, and will then be considered for entries special students by the host institutions.
- 7) Each institution will appoint an individual to act as the coordinator for the exchange.

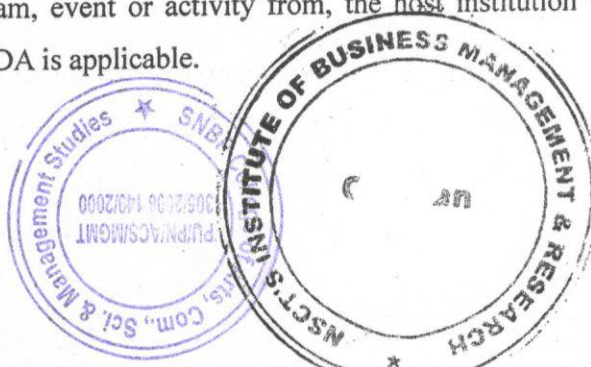
FIELDS OF COOPERATION -

The institutes undertake to maintain and develop their academic, cultural, social and sports cooperation within the frame of their respective skills, through the exchange of experiences with priority in the following fields:

- Institutional cooperation;
- Development of the practice in context to various curricular, cocurricular and extra curricular activities.
- Support of the participation in women empowerment program.
- Exchange of expertise in curricular and cocurricular as guest lecture.
- Training & workshop resources of executives;
- Organization of events like conference, Seminar.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 1) Nothing in this MOU shall be deemed to be a commitment or obligation of funds from the both the institutes or parties or any of their various components. If any special financial consideration will there that will be taken separately.
- 2) The participants students in the exchange will not pay fees (or any other fees) for the respective program, event or activity from, the host institution will consider exchange as guest. No TA & DA is applicable.



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





RESOURCES AND REGULATIONS AT THE HOST INSTITUTION

1. Students and faculty from exchange will be free to use various resources while the events and program. It needs to prior intimation to respective head of department.
2. At the end of the event the participants in the exchange will request the host institution to send to the home institution a report/official transcript of their participation records and triumph.
3. Exchange students are subject to the rules and regulations of the host institution. The host institution reserves the right to dismiss any participating student at any time for personal misconduct. The dismissal of a participant shall not abrogate the agreement for the arrangements regarding other participants.

DURATION, AMENDMENT AND TERMINATION OF THIS AGREEMENT

- 1) The parties will review the terms of the MOU annually to assess the success of the exchange, and will determine whether to continue, modify or discontinue the MOU.
- 2) This MOU shall take effect when signed by both parties, and will remain in effect for a period of 3 years. Thereafter, it has to be renewed for another period.
