ANNUAL REPORT 2023-24

SNBP College of Art Commerce Science& Management Studies was established in academic year 2008 under the governance of SE Society with the moto "Kindle The Light Of Knowledge & Love" with the UG & PG courses.

SNBPACS is the activity-based college, which enhance the abilities of students through various activities. In academic year 2023-24 the college has organized & Participated in more than 68 plus activities. The college has conducting various programs to build up students' ability, confidence, communication skills & the performance. These programmers help students to make them responsible citizens. College is accredited B++ Grade by NAAC, as well as our college is also Certified by ISO 210001:2018.

In the present academic year, the students Strength is 840 which is more than academic year 2022-23. For the academic development the college provided well equipped Library & Computer Lab to the student with the Lectures. The result of this, 41 students have got Distinction, 78 students have got First Class and 8 are in Pass Class in final year of University Examination.





१ मे १९६० साली "मुंबई सह संयुक्त महाराष्ट्राची" स्थापना झाली.

१९४६ साली "संयुक्त महाराष्ट्र समिती" स्थापना करण्यात आली ती "मराठी भाषिकांसाठी"," संयुक्त महाराष्ट्र" राज्य स्थापन करण्यासाठी. सरदार वल्लभभाई पटेल यांनी नमुद केलं होतं की 'मुंबईचा विकास हा फक्त गुजराती भाषिकांमुळे झाला आहे.

डिसेंबर १९७३ साली "राज्य पुनर्रचना आयोग" स्थापन करण्यात आला तर या आयोगाने १९७७ साली आपला अहवाल सादर करून आपल्या अकलेचे तारे तोडले. अहवालात असं म्हटलं होत की, मुंबईच्या विकासासाठी, मुंबईला गुजराती भाषिकांचा सौराष्ट्रात समाविष्ट करून "मुंबई प्रांत" बनवावा. "बेळगाव-कारवार" आर्थिकदृष्ट्या कर्नाटकला जोडले असल्याने ते "संयुक्त महाराष्ट्र" राज्याला देणे शक्य नाही आणि जर "विदर्भ" दिला तर "नागपूर"चे महत्त्व कमी होईल, तर मुंबई साठी द्विभाषिक धोरण . आयोगाच्या अहवालानंतर नेहरुंनी, सौराष्ट्र सह गुजरात, विदर्भासह महाराष्ट्र आणि मुंबई प्रांत वेगळा असा शिराज्य सिद्धांत मांडला आणि "संयुक्त महाराष्ट्र चळवळी"ने पेट घेतला." मा. यशवंतराव चव्हाणांनी म्हटलं होत की नेहरू आणि संयुक्त महाराष्ट्र यात मला नेहरू जास्त महत्त्वाचे वाटतात" आणि " मुंबईसह संयुक्त महाराष्ट्र झालाच पाहिजे " हे चळवळीचे घोषवाक्य बनले.

२० नोट्हेंबर १९७७ मध्ये मुंबईत केलेल्या भाषणात काँग्रेसचे नेते, स.का.पाटील बोलले की "५००० वर्षानंतर ही मुंबई महाराष्ट्राला मिळणार नाही" तर मोरारजी देसाई यांनी ,"काँग्रेस जिवंत असे पर्यंत तरी मुंबई मिळणार नाही" अशी "भीष्मप्रतिज्ञा" घेतली आणि मराठी जनतेचा उद्रेक झाला, २१ नोट्हेंबर ला झालेल्या आंदोलनातील गोळीबारात काही जणांना प्राण गमवावे लागले. जानेवारी १९७६ मध्ये मुंबईला केंद्रशासित प्रदेश घोषित करण्यात आले.त्याविरोधात सत्याग्रहे,आंदोलने,मोर्च निघाले. लोकांवर सत्तेचा गैरवापर करून अमानुषपणे गोळीबार करण्यात आला. एकूण १०५ लोकांना या चळवळीत आपले प्राण गमवावे लागले.केंद्रीय अर्थमंत्री देशमुख यांनी राजीनामा दिल्यानं चळवळीला बळ मिळाले. पुढे होणाऱ्या निवडणुका लक्षात घेता ,आणि चक्क ६० कोटी रुपयांचा बदल्यात मुंबईला अक्षरशः विकत घेऊन ,महाराष्ट्राला मिळाली. (भारत-पाकिस्तान फाळणी दरम्यान पाकिस्तानला दिलेली रक्कम होती ती ५५ कोटी रुपये आणि इथे स्वतंत्र भारतात अशी घटना घडली आहे)परंतु बेळगाव-कारवार-निपाणी सोडून १ मे १९६० रोजी , नेहरंग्ना हवे असलेले "मुंबई" हे नाव वगळ्न "महाराष्ट्र" हया नावावर शिक्कामोर्तब करण्यात आले.आणि "दिल्ली महाराष्ट्रापुढे झुकली"

"भाषावार प्रांतरचनेनुसार "मराठी" भाषिकांसाठी "महाराष्ट्र" राज्याची स्थापना झाली तर खरी पण त्यासाठी १०५ हुतात्म्यांना आपल्या प्राणाची आहुती द्यावी लागली होती हे विसरता कामा नये.आज ही "संयुक्त महाराष्ट्र" अपूर्ण अवस्थेत आहे. हया १०५ हुतात्म्यांच बलिदान व्यर्थ जाता कामा नये. ज्या दिवशी "बेळगाव-कारवार-निपाणी" सह "संयुक्त महाराष्ट्र" अस्तित्वात येईल त्या दिवशी या हुतात्म्यांना खरी श्रद्धांजली असेल.न्यायव्यवस्थेवर संपुर्ण विश्वास आहे यात "महाराष्ट्राला" न्याय मिळेल हीच अपेक्षा आहे.



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
English Literature: A Mirror of Society





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
HIGHWAY HYPNOSIS

The cause of most of the accidents is said to be highway hypnosis or sleepiness during driving. So far, 98 mishaps have taken place due to sleep hypnosis, while nine have died in such incidents.

Second major cause of deaths on Samruddhi Mahamarg is over-speeding and tyre burst. Between the mentioned period, 68 cases of over-speeding were reported, of which 11 people were killed, 72 wounded and 19 grievously injured. As many as 55 accidents took place due to tyre burst, leaving nine dead.
