- 1 Copy of attested Leaving Certificate.
- Affidavit for Gap Certificate (if there is gap in education)
- 5 passport size photographs.
- Original Migration Certificate.

### **RULES REGARDING REFUND OF FEES**

- 1) If a student withdraws his admission within 10 days of his date of admission – 80% of the fees paid will be refunded.
- 2) If a student withdraws his admission within 11 days to 1 month of the date of admission – 60% of fees paid will be refunded.

## FEES INSTRUCTION

### Payment of Tuition Fees:

#### SPOT ADMISSION OR INSTALLMENT FACILITY

1. Payment for SPOT ADMISSION – Full amount to be paid at the time of admission.
2. INSTALLMENT FACILITY
  - Students who take admission for various courses need to pay 50% of the tuition fees at the time of admissions.
  - Remaining amount in one installments payable by PDC, PDC's not to exceed 10th of September of the academic year.
3. Late fees applicable if:
  - Installments not paid by 10th of the allotted month
  - Post dated cheque bounces
  - Extended installments are allotted (if any)
4. There will be additional fees applicable as per university rule.  
(for students from other states/foreign countries)

(No relaxation for fees submission, do not approach for the same reason)

### Other Fees to be paid

**Eligibility fees :** To be paid from 30th July to 15th August (applicable only for new admissions)

**Exam fees :** To be paid for every semester separately, dates as per university declaration.

**Project Fees :** Applicable according to project subject added to the course/semester. Project to be paid along with exam fees.

### Rules for Refund: (terms applicable only if total fees are paid) i.e.,

- 20% of the fees will be deducted on cancellation of the admission between 1st day and 10th day from the date of securing admission.
- 40% of the total fees will be deducted if the admission is cancelled between the 11th day and 30th day from the date of securing admission.
- NO REFUND will be given under any circumstances, if the admission is cancelled after 30 days.
- Refund of fees is to be collected after 15 days after submitting the original fees receipt and a written application in person within the prescribed time limit.
- If there is any change in the fee structure or rules for regulating admission in the institute as per the specified regulating body Pune University, will be informed by issuing circulars or notification in the institute notice board. The students will have to pay any difference or hike in the fee structure for regulating admission in the institute.

### Submission of documents:

- Submission of original Transfer Certificate after graduation is compulsory.
- Submission of original Migration Certificate is applicable to students from other University.
- Submission of Gap certificate is applicable for students who have gap for more than one year after completion of any course.
- Attested copies of mark sheets to be submitted at the time of admission.

### Application for Transfer Certificate:

After successful completion of course students are supposed to apply for issuance of transfer certificate along with amount of Rs. 150 and a written application to the institute office.

## ANTI RAGGING ACT - 1999

### Sec. 2 (C) Ragging :

Ragging means display of disorderly conduct, doing of any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm raise apprehension or fear of shame or embarrassment in any educational institution and includes : teasing, abusing, threatening or playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such students, or asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course, willingly do.

S.3 Prohibition of ragging within or outside any educational institution is prohibited.

S.4 Penalty for ragging : Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonments for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to a fine may extend to ten thousand rupees.

S.5 Dismissal of Student : Any student convicted of an offence under S.4 penalty for ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.

S.6 Suspension of Student:

1) Whenever any student of as the case may be, the parent or guardian, or a teacher of an educational institution complaints, in writing of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of that educational institution shall, without prejudice of the forgoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint and if, prima facie, it is found true suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action.

2) Where, on inquiry by the head of the educational institution, it is proved that there is no substance prima facie, in the complainant received under subsection (1), he/she shall intimate the fact, in writing to the complainant.

3) The decision of the head of the educational institution that the student has indulged in ragging under subsection (1) shall be final.

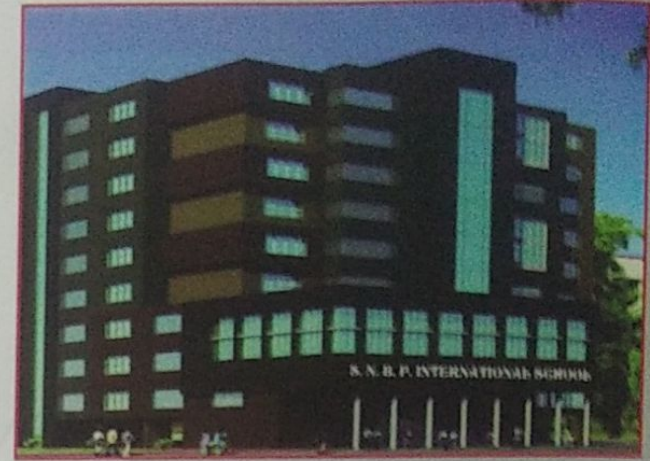

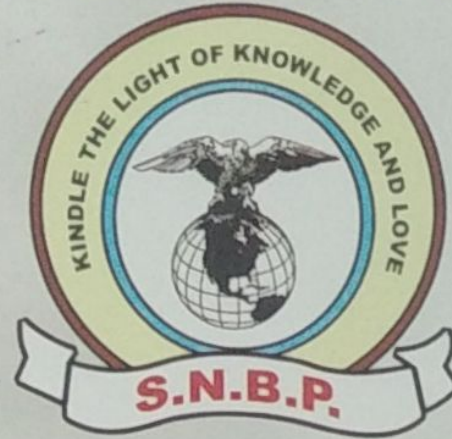
